Aqueous extract of Sri Lankan *Erythrina* indica leaves has sedative but not analgesic activity

Abstract

In contrast to what was reported for the Indian plant, the aqueous leaf extract of Sri Lankan *Erythrina indica* showed potent sedative activity but no analgesic effects, as claimed by Sri Lankan Ayurvedic physicians. © 1999 Elsevier Science B.V. All rights reserved.
