I am delighted to send this message on the occasion of Annual Academic Sessions of the

Traditionally, research has been one of the main functions of the University. This function

objective related to Knowledge Economy.

I hope the Academic Sessions will highlight the multifaceted dimensions of the knowledge

economy would flourish for the betterment of Sri Lankan polity.
