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ABSTRACT

budies with Osbeckia octandra using Sprague Dawley rats as experimental animals have shown that the aqueous extract of the leaves of this plant can significantly lower the fasting blood plucose level and markedly improve the glucose tolerance. Biological testing of fractions sepatated from a methanolic extract of the Osbeckia leaves showed that only the ethylacetate fraction and the aqueous fraction remaining after solvent extraction exhibited hypoglycaemic this biological testing after chemical screening and separation by thin layer chromatogrative (TLC) of the above active fractions has shown that a mixture of two flavanoids and anther compound which is possibly a flavanoid derivative are responsible for the hypoglycaenic activity of this plant.
