Objective of this description cross sectional study in to describe the pattern of obstetric morbidity and some factors related to that pattern of morbidity and to identify some aspects of health care utilization among mothers in the study population. Obstetric morbidity affects women with a wide ranging spectrum of disease. The enormity of this problem calls for the immediate attention of health planners and policy makers .More research should be encouraged to identify factors underlying obstetric morbidity.
