The median age at first viable pregnancy was 24 years. The mean age difference between the marriage and the pregnancy was 0.96 years. When the level of the education increases the age at first viable pregnancy also increased. Ensuring education of the girl child at least up to the completion of the secondary education will improve many aspects related to the reproductive health of the woman. Considering the declining age at menarche the integration of the reproductive health to the formal education at a suitable level will be beneficial.
