The study review that the attitudes towards maternal care family planning among husbands were favourable. But their knowledge about above subjects was poor. It was noted that the knowledge of husbands in rural sector were poor that the urban sector, in most of the factors considered in the study. It was highlighted that friends were the main source of information. But there desire is to get information from mass media, health personnel, and books.
