Entries in the Subject Index are listed under specific subject headings based on Medical Subject Headings MeSH (1992). Subject headings are arranged alphabetically, and under each subject heading, entries are listed alphabetically under the first named author.

Each entry gives the name of the author/s, title of the article, Volume No., issue No., year and pagination.

Names of all authors who have contributed to the articles have been included in the Author Index.

The Keyword Index provides both MeSH and Non-MeSH keywords to facilitate searching of relevant articles.
