INTRODUCTION

The Ceylon Journal of Medical Science is the successor to the former section 'D' of the Ceylon Journal of Science founded in 1924 by the Government of Ceylon for the publication of scientific research. With the establishment of the University of Ceylon in 1942, the administration of the Ceylon Journal of Science was handed over to the University. It consisted of several sections, each section having a separate publication and appearing independently from Vols. 1-5. Medical research was published in Section 'D'.

From Vol.6, the Ceylon Journal of Science - Section 'D' was termed the Ceylon Journal of Medical Science (being section D of the Ceylon Journal of Science) and in 1965 this section was re-named the Ceylon Journal of Medical Science and thus became an independent journal. When, in 1967, the University of Ceylon, Colombo, became an independent university, it took over the administration of this journal. The Ceylon Journal of Medical Science was a bi-annual publication.

The index consists of a subject section and an author index. The subject headings are based on Medical Subject Headings 1983 (MeSH). The subject index entries are listed under the specific headings. Under each heading entries are listed alphabetically. All entries are entered under the author named first in the article, and when more than three authors are responsible for an article the entry is made under the title, according to AACR 2nd ed.

Each entry gives the name of the author, title, volume number, issue number, year and the pagination.

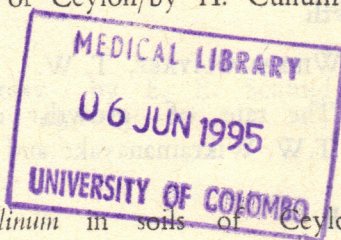
